

Carbonic anhydrase III Human, Recombinant, *E. coli*

Description: Carbonic anhydrase III is one of a group of ten zinc

metalloenzymes that catalyse the reversible hydration of CO₂ to form HCO₃-. CAIII is a cytoplasmic isoenzyme, but

is released into the circulation following injury.

RANDOX recombinant CAIII comprises a 260 amino acid fragment (1-260) corresponding to the mature CAIII protein and is expressed in *E. coli* with an amino-terminal hexahistidine tag. This product is for research use only and

is not intended for diagnostic or therapeutic use.

Form: Liquid.

Supplied in 1x Laemmli Buffer (25mM Tris-HCl pH6.8, 50mM

DTT,

1%(w/v) SDS, 0.1%(w/v) Bromophenol Blue, 2.5% Glycerol).
